Statement of Evidence:

North Quarter Corner Section 32, Township 139 North, Range 30 West, 5th Principal Meridian.

The Original Public Land Survey was run in 1865 and a wood post was set to mark the corner.

In 1906, Mr. John Curo set an $8" \times 8" \times 36"$ concrete post at a lost location which fit the roots of the original bearing trees.

In 1930, the Minnesota State Highway Department found the concrete monument and called for it 17.0 feet west of P.I. Station 598+74.1.

In 1967, the Minnesota State Highway Department found a 2" iron pipe at the corner location.

In 1981, the Minnesota Department of Transportation found a spike at the corner location. The spike fits the lost location of 1906 and is 17.0 feet west of P.I. Station 598+74.1 as called for in 1930.

The Minnesota Department of Transportation accepts the spike as a perpetuation of the original Government corner. as established by Mr. Curo in 1906.
