

Statement of Evidence:

In 1919, Albinus N. Kimmel, a US cadastral engineer set a 1"x36" iron pipe with brass cap for the CE 1/16 corner from which he marked the following bt"s, a 6" aspen S 70-1/4 E 40 links and a 14" jackpine N 61-1/2 W 105 links.

On 12-23-1982, Walter E. Curo, a registered land surveyor and Ken Metcalf found the 1" pipe with brass cap bent over. We find no evidence of original bt's. We set a 2"x5' iron pipe with brass cap in place of the bent pipe and mark new bt's as shown on the front.
