

Statement of Evidence:

In 1921, Earl Harrington, a US surveyor set a 1"x36" iron pipe with brass cap for SMC, from which he marked the following bt's, a 6" maple N 17-45 W 24 links and a 12" maple S 78-15 W 55 links.

On 2-23-1983, Walter E. Curo, a registered land surveyor and Ken Metcalf found the 1" iron pipe with brass cap standing in good condition. There is no trace of the 6" maple N 17 W. There is a large dead and rotting tree uprooted S 78 W 55 links. We mark new bt's as shown on the front.
