
NORTHEAST Corner of Section 3, Township 139, Range 29, 5th P.M.

Original Government Survey

Corner set in 1865 by Walker & Wright

In 1973 Myron Landecker, Registered Land Surveyor #7452, used this
2" I.P. corner in survey in Section 3, Township 139, Range 29

On 3/26/79 Myron Landecker again used corner to establish North line
of Section 3, Township 139, Range 29

On 7/17/81 Landecker again used corner for section survey

In 1942 J.W. Curo found a 2" iron pipe and marked new BT's.

In 1956 J. Howard used this corner in the plat of Island View Acres.
Myron Landecker believes this corner to be a perpetuation of the
original Government corner as established from previous surveys.
