

Statement of Evidence:

- 1874 U.S. General Land Office survey set wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 8" Poplar S 85 E 11 links.
- 1919 U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey reestablished this corner by proportionate distance. No evidence found of original corner. An iron pipe with a marked brass cap was set to mark the corner. The following bearing trees were marked: 16" N. Pine N 66-45 E 134 links and 14" W. Pine N 87-30 W 64 links.
- 1940 U.S. Forest Service records show the following: CCC records show brass cap monument and W. Pine bearing West 63 links found. Fence lines north, south, and east.
- 1982 County Surveyor's Records in the Recorder's Office were checked and no resurvey information was found on this corner.
- 1982 Analysis of the above data indicates that the location of this Government corner has been perpetuated. I accepted the monument as marking the corner location as when set in 1919 by the GLO resurvey based on bearing tree evidence.
