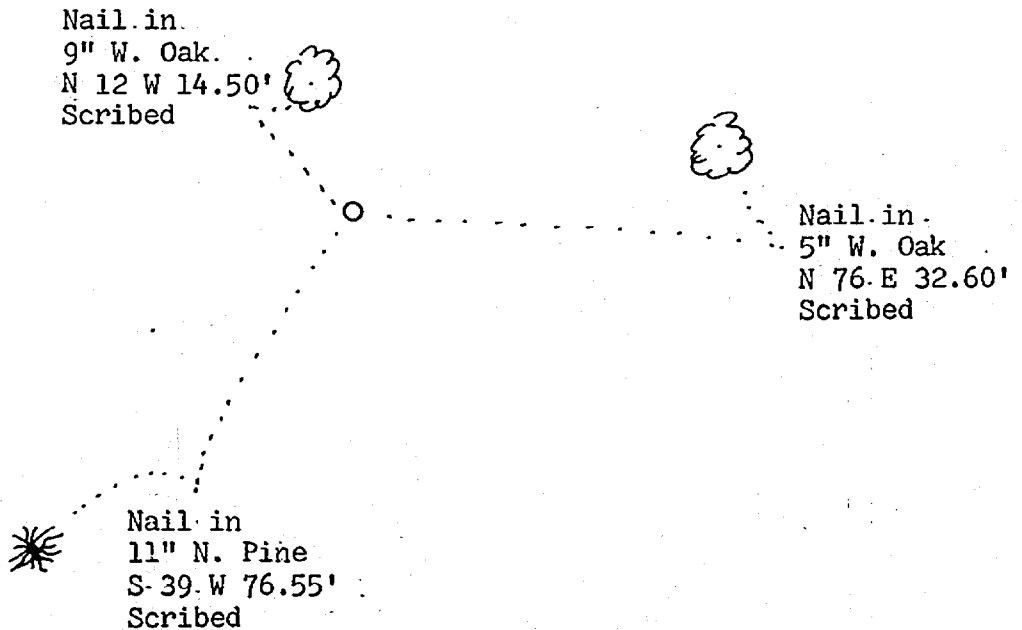
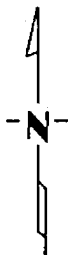

Statement of Evidence:

- 1919 U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey established this corner and an iron pipe with a marked brass cap was set to mark the corner. The following bearing trees were marked: 10" J. Pine S 28-30 E 28 links and 12" J. Pine N 36 W 21 links.
- 1936 U.S. Forest Service records show the following: CCC notes show brass cap iron pipe found and both J. Pine bearing trees. One new tree was listed as 14" N. Pine South 130 links.
- 1980 U.S. Forest Service technician C. Krause found the corner monumented with a GLO brass cap monument in good condition up 8". The following bearing trees were found: J. Pine stump S 28 E 18.5' and J. Pine stump N 36 W 13.7' with visible scribe marks. Three new bearing trees were marked and are shown on this certificate. Old fence post on east side of iron with wire running north and west.
- 1982 County Surveyor's Records in the Recorder's Office were checked and no resurvey information was found on this corner.
- 1982 Analysis of the above data indicates that the location of this Government corner has been perpetuated. I accepted the monument as marking the corner location as when set in 1919 by the GLO resurvey based on bearing tree evidence.
