

Statement of Evidence:

- 1919 U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey established this corner and an iron pipe with a marked brass cap was set to mark the corner. The following bearing trees were marked: 8" Poplar S 36-15 E 62 links and 12" Poplar S 53-15 W 90 links. The notes show corner position falls in a pond and a witness corner set 4.12 chains south of the true position on the section line.
- 1980 U.S. Forest Service technician C. Krause found the corner monumented with a GLO brass cap iron monument in good condition leaning south. The following bearing trees were found: large rotted stump S 36 E 40.9' and large depression S 53 W 59.4'. Three new bearing trees were marked and are shown on this certificate. Corner is in grassy marsh 20' north of high ground. Monument was straightened and rocks piled around it. Chained distance south to East $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Sec. 19 which checked good with the 1919 GLO resurvey record.
- 1982 County Surveyor's Records in the Recorder's Office were checked and no resurvey information was found on this corner.
- 1982 Analysis of the above data indicates that the location of this Government corner has been perpetuated. I accepted the monument as marking the corner location as when set in 1919 by the GLO resurvey based on bearing tree evidence.
