Statement of Evidence:

- U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey established this corner and an iron pipe with a marked brass cap was set to mark the corner. The following bearing trees were marked: 8" Basswood N 40-30 E 34 links and 10" Ash S 27 W 52 links.
- County Surveyors Record Book D page 75 show survey by J.H. Flynn. Notes show government iron found.
- U.S. Forest Service technician C. Krause found the corner monumented with a GLO brass cap monument in good condition up 12". The following bearing trees were found: 27" Ash N 43 W 34.3' with overgrown scar and old Basswood stump with four sprouts N.41 E 22.4'. Three new bearing trees were marked and are shown on this certificate.
- Analysis of the above data indicates that the location of this Government corner has been perpetuated. I accepted the monument as marking the corner location as when set in 1919 by the GLO resurvey based on bearing tree evidence.
