Statement of Evidence:

- U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey established this corner and an iron pipe with a marked brass cap was set to mark the corner. The following bearing trees were marked: 8" N. Pine S 43-30 E 119 links and 8" W. Pine N 59-45 W 284 links.
- U.S. Forest Service technician C. Krause found the corner monumented with a GLO brass cap monument in good condition up 1.5'. The following bearing trees were found: 22" N. Pine S 44 E 78.5' and 10" W. Pine stump, burnt, with scribe visible N 60 W 187.4'. Three new bearing trees were marked and are shown on this certificate. Corner falls in swamp. Placed rocks around the monument.
- 1982 County Surveyor's Records in the Recorder's Office were checked and no resurvey information was found on this corner.
- Analysis of the above data indicates that the location of this Government corner has been perpetuated. I accepted the monument as marking the corner location as when set in 1919 by the GLO resurvey based on bearing tree evidence.
