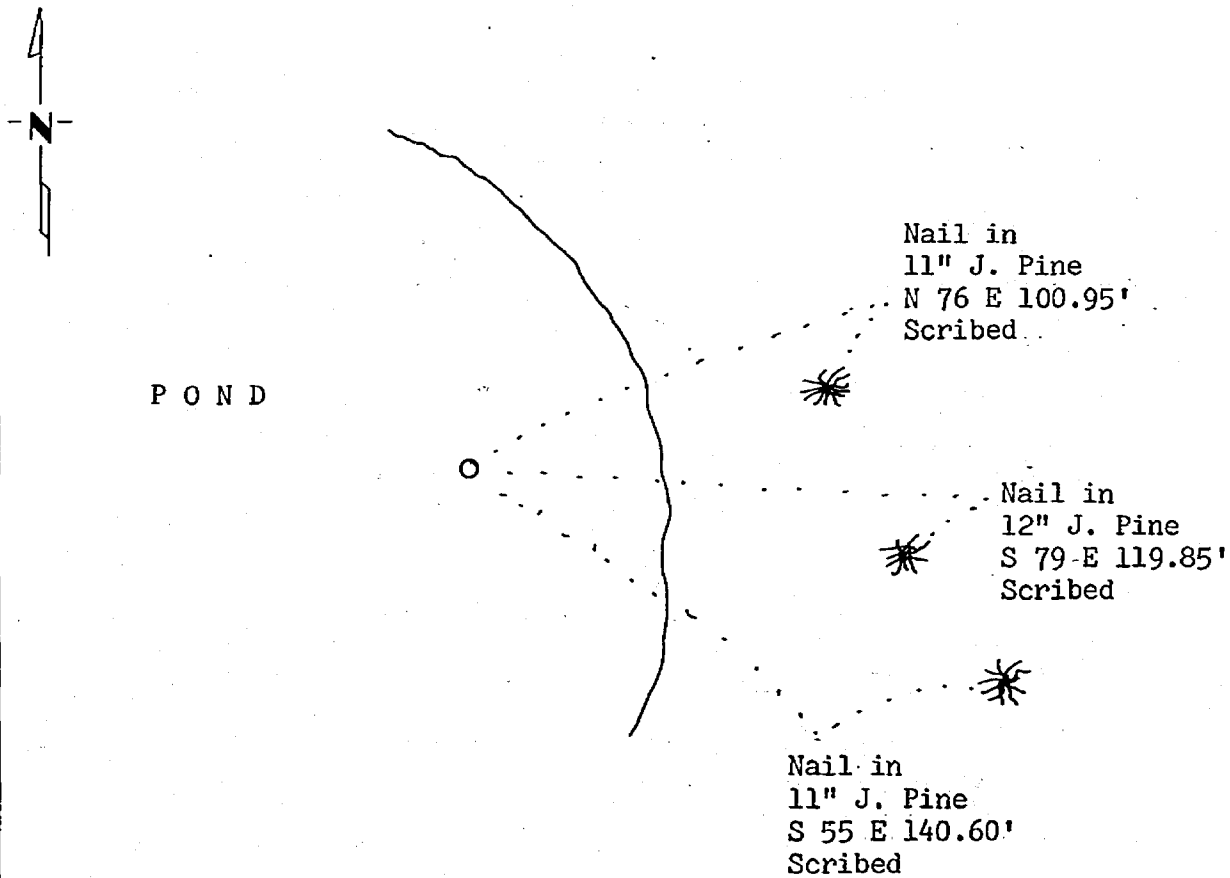

DOCUMENT NO. 279375

Statement of Evidence:

- 1874 U.S. General Land Office survey set wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 8" N. Pine S 77 E 160 links and 14" N. Pine N 60 E 170 links.
- 1918 U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey found the corner marked by wood stake and witnessed by original bearing tree evidence: 20" Pine stump N 52 E 170 links and 25" decayed Pine stump S 72½ E 160 links. An iron pipe with a marked brass cap was set to mark the corner. The following bearing trees were marked: No trees available. Raised mound of stone west of the corner.
- 1980 U.S. Forest Service technician C. Krause found the corner monumented with a GLO brass cap monument in good condition 24" under water in small pond. Rock mound around corner. The following bearing trees were found: Original Pine stump N 52 E 112.2', burned and rotted, but some axe marks still visible. Four new bearing trees were marked and are shown on this certificate.
- 1982 County Surveyor's Records in the Recorder's Office were checked and no resurvey information was found on this corner.
- 1982 Analysis of the above data indicates that the location of this Government corner has been perpetuated. I accepted the monument as marking the corner location as when set in 1918 by the GLO resurvey based on bearing tree evidence.
