Statement of Evidence:

og kontaka ki ki ji gafar iyi Farint iyi ka kingili U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey established this. 1926 corner and an iron pipe with a marked brass cap was set to mark the corner. The following bearing trees were marked: 12" Ash S 62 E 54 links and 10" Ironwood N 6 W 13 links. 1970 U.S. Forest Service records show the following: S. Morrison found the brass cap monument. 1980 U.S. Forest Service technician G. Brama found the corner monumented with a GLO brass cap monument in good condition up 12". The following bearing trees were found: Rotted Ash stub laying on the ground at S 62 E 35.6'. No evidence found of the Ironwood. Three new bearing trees were marked and are shown on this certificate. Steel sign posts were set south and east of the corner. 1982 County Surveyor's Records in the Recorder's Office were checked and no resurvey information was found on this corner. 1982 Analysis of the above data indicates that the location of this Government corner has been perpetuated. I accepted the monument as marking the corner location as when set in 1926 by the GLO resurvey based on bearing tree evidence.
