Statement of Evidence:

- U.S. General Land Office survey set wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 7" Ash S 53 E 28 links, 10" Poplar N 67 E 21 links, 9" Poplar N 33 W 34 links, and 6" Maple S 52 W 31 links.
- U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey reestablished this corner by record measurements from the north and west, which checks with Tamarack swamp call by original notes. Corner to the east was not used. No evidence of the original corner was found. An iron pipe with a marked brass cap was set to mark the corner. The following bearing trees were marked: 12" Poplar N 35-30 E 19 links, 5" Spruce S 77-45 E 34 links, 14" Poplar S 63 W 27 links, and 4" Balsam N 48 W 3 links.
- U.S. Forest Service technician G. Brama found the corner monumented with a GLO brass cap monument in good condition up 12". The following bearing trees were found: Rotted Poplar stump at N 36 E.12.5' and Rotted Spruce stump at S.77 E 22.4'. No evidence was found of the other two trees. Four new bearing trees were marked and are shown on this certificate. Steel sign posts were set east and north of the corner.
- 1982 County-Surveyor's Records in the Recorder's Office were checked and no resurvey information was found on this corner.
- Analysis of the above data indicates that the location of this Government corner has been perpetuated. I accepted the monument as marking the corner location as when set in 1926 by the GLO resurvey based on bearing tree evidence.
