IN 1863 A POST WAS SET INTTHE ORIGINAL SURVEY WITH THE FOLLOWING BT'S, TAMARACK 8" NORTH 10 WEST 162 LKS 106.92 FEET.

IN SEPTEMBER OF 1929, JOHN W. CURO A REGISTERED LAND SURVEYOR FOUND THE STUMP OF THE OLD NORTHWEST BT FROM WHICH HE SET A 2" PIPE 5 FEET LONG WITH 6 FOOT MOUND OF BOG 3 FEET HIGH WITH TRENCH CUT AT THE BASE.

IN DECEMBER OF 1984, WALTER E. CURO A REGISTERED LAND SURVEYOR AND KEN METCALF FIND THE 2" IRON PIPE IN THE BOG WITH THE 6 FOOT DIAMETER TRENCH STILL VISIBLE. THE MOUND IS ABOUT 1 FOOT HIGH. THERE ARE NO TREES REASONABLY CLOSE FOR NEW BT'S.
