1873 - The original Public Land Survey was run by P.H. Conger. A wood post was set to mark the corner and two bearing trees were recorded as accessories:

7" Oak S 19°W 23 links (15.18')

1921 - Elmer B. Horst Deputy Cass County Surveyor subdivided Sections 30 and 31. He found no evidence of the original corner or its accessories. Set a 2" X 48" iron at lost proportioned distance. Record Book C, page 452.

1959 - Harold Curo Cass County Surveyor found the 2" x 48" iron set by Horst in 1921
He replaced 2 inch iron with a stamped 3 inch brass capped monument and recorded three new accessories:

1984 - Kerick Surveying, Inc., Bemidji, MN. found the 3 inch stamped brass capped monument set by Curo in 1959. Used this monument as found in subdividing Sections 30 and 31 for the U.S. Forest Service. Also found the accessories marked by Curo. The NW bearing tree was lying dead remarked his bearing trees and set one new bearing tree and metal fence post that appear on this certificate.
