



Statement of Evidence: Northeast Corner of Section 9, Township 141 North, Range 31 West, 5th Principal Meridian.

1873 P.H. Conger, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, set a post for this Section corner in his subdivision of the Township between August 5, 1873 and August 30, 1873.

As references he scribed:

Norway Pine	18 inch	N49°E	23 links	(15.18 feet)
Norway Pine	24 inch	N61°W	56 links	(36.96 feet)
Norway Pine	24 inch	S46°W	50 links	(33.0 feet)
Norway Pine	18 inch	S42°E	64 links	(42.24 feet)

1924 J. Greene, Cass County Surveyor, set an iron pipe to perpetuate this corner in his survey of Section 4.

1962 Peter J. Meyer, R.L.S. with U.S.F.S. found evidence of original BT's. There was no evidence of the iron pipe Greene had set in 1924. A 2½ inch (O.D.) x 5 foot long iron pipe with a 3 inch diameter brass cap was set to perpetuate corner and references made as follows:

Jack Pine	14 inch	N69°E	100.7 feet
Oak	14 inch	S6°E	18.2 feet
6 ft steel post		East	2.0 feet

1984 Kelly M. Booge, under F.S. Contract No. 53-6392-4-00996, made a thorough search for physical evidence of this corner on August 30 and found the 1962 monument lying down with cap broke off. He found Northwest and Southeast BT's from 1962 in good condition. The Northeast BT is now a 5 foot high stub. He returned November 12 and reset a monument for the corner from remaining BT's and added additional references as shown on the sketch. This Certificate was made to update the 1963 Certificate, Document No. 158, in book of Corner Certificates in Cass County Recorder's Office.
