Statement of Evidence:

N9

This corner was originally established in April, 1876, by B.C. Baldwin, Deputy Surveyor. The field notes of that survey are filed in the office of the Secretary of State, St. Paul, Minnesota. Mr. Baldwin's notes state that a post was set to mark the corner and referenced by the following:

A 8" Tamarack that bears N36°E a distance of 13 links [8.58 feet]
A 10" Tamarack that bears S34°E a distance of 50 links [33.00 feet]
A 5" Spruce that bears S18°W a distance of 28 links [18.48 feet]
A 5" Cedar that bears N82°W a distance of 19 links [12.54 feet]

On June 14, 1984, personnel from Advance Surveying & Engineering Co. made a thorough search for this corner and the above mentioned references. We find an original Bearing Tree. The upper blaze is open and scribing visable, also on lower blaze. From this Bearing Tree we set a temporary corner and search. At N36°E - 8.58 feet we find a 14" Tamarack stump with lower blaze evident. At S34°E - 33.00 feet we find remains of a Tamarack stump. At S18°W - 18.48 feet we find remains of a stump.

On December 14, 1984, an additional search was made by Advance prior to reestablishing this corner from the found Bearing Trees, as shown on the sketch.
