This corner was originally established in April, 1876, by B.C. Baldwin, Deputy Surveyor. The field notes of that survey are filed in the office of the Secretary of State, St. Paul, Minnesota. Mr. Baldwin's notes state that a post was set to mark the corner and referenced by the following:

A 5" Cedar that bears N10°E a distance of 15 links [9.90 feet]
A 6" Tamarack that bears S89°E a distance of 22 links [14.52 feet]
A 6" Cedar that bears S38°W a distance of 36 links [23.76 feet]
A 6" Tamarack that bears N65°W a distance of 9 links [5.94 feet]

On March 15, 1984, personnel from Advance Surveying & Engineering Co. made a thorough search for this corner and the above mentioned references. We find an original Bearing Tree. The upper blaze is open and scribing visable. No trace of other Bearing Trees.

On December 20, 1984, an additional search was made by Advance prior to reestablishing this corner from the found Bearing Tree. The Bearing Tree used bears N10°E a distance of 9.90 feet from the corner, as shown on the sketch.
