

DOCUMENT NO. 281876

- 1870 U.S. General Land Office Survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 20" Norway Pine N28½°E 10 lks., 15" Norway Pine S65¼°W 30 lks.
- 1915 County Survey Record Book "D" page 11, shows a survey by P.M. Scott, signed by James Flynn, County Surveyor. He found both GLO bearing trees and set the corner.
- 1983 On August 2, Survey Technician Terry Freeman and Forester Larry Olson, found a 2x54" I.P., up 3½' and both GLO bearing tree stumps at bearing and distance, with axe marks.
- 1985 On March 22, County Surveyor Walt Curo and Survey Technician Terry Freeman, removed found pipe and placed a 2x2x36" iron with stamped aluminum cap and placed the found pipe 0.2' west of corner. The following new bearing trees were marked: 4" White Pine N38°E 14.70', 4" White Pine S89°E 26.92' and a 4" Maple N77°W 10.13'.
