
East one quarter Corner of Section 24, Township 138, Range 32, 5th P.M.

DOCUMENT NO. 281878

- 1860 U.S. General Land Office Survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 28" Red Oak N28°W 29 lks., 4" Aspen East 9 lks.
- 1917 County Survey Record Book "C" page 63, shows a survey by E.B. Horst. He set a 2x48" iron monument and marked the following bearing trees: 9" Jack Pine N54°30'E 31.5', 4" Poplar N40°W 41.0'.
- 1983 Survey Technician Terry Freeman and Forester Dan Marcum found a 2" I.P. down 1.5' in centerline of County Road #112.
- 1985 County Surveyor Walt Curo and Survey Technician Terry Freeman, set a 4" x 14" cast iron monument over found iron and marked the following bearing trees: 10" White Pine N46°W 50.77', 10" Red Oak S45°W 68.59', 5" Burr Oak N76°E 106.78', 4" Burr Oak S76°E 93.81'
