

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE FOR: East quarter corner, Section 17,  
Township 133 North, Range 31 West, Cass County, Minnesota.

In 1863, the original Government Survey was performed and a wood post was set to mark this corner location.

In 1921 E. B. Horst surveyed the North-South section line between said Section 17 and Section 16, said township. No monument was set. County Book "D", Page 495

In 1981 & 1982, Alle Welle, RES #11873 while surveying in adjacent sections found 1915 and 1921 Horst surveys to have an error in distances measured and used in determination of section subdivisions.

In 1984 & 1985 Landecker & Associates, Inc. concur with Welle findings and re-established said East quarter as lost and set by single proportionate measure.

Landecker & Associates, Inc. accept this monument to be a perpetration of the original Government corner.
