



STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE FOR: Northeast corner of Section 16, Township 133 North, Range 31 West, Cass County, Minnesota.

In 1863, the original Government Survey was performed and a wood post was set to mark this corner location.

In 1915 E. B. Horst set 4" x 4" x 36" wood post while surveying for Township road in said Township. County Book "C", page 86.

In 1981 Alle Welle, RLS #11873 reset a computed position for this corner using several of E. H. Horst's other section corners as control.

In 1984 and 1985 Landecker & Associates, Inc. while surveying in Section 16 re-established this corner using E. B. Horst 1915 survey data of which the Northwest, East quarter and Southeast corners of said Section 16 were found and used in re-establishing this corner position. This position also fits the location as established by Welle while surveying in Section 15 said township.

Landecker & Associates, Inc. accepts this monument as the perpetuation of the original Government Survey.
