

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE FOR: Northeast corner, Section 30, Township 135 North, Range 29 West, Cass County, Minnesota.

In 1865 the original Government Survey was performed and a wood post was set to mark this corner location.

In 1906 J. Curo set 4 x 4 post from found original stake and stump of original Northeast bearing tree. County Book "B", page 128-131.

In 1916 E. B. Horst found wood post and stump of original Northeast bearing tree and set a 2" X 48" flue. County Book "B", page 538-541.

In 1978 Cass County Highway Department finds 2" pipe while doing survey work on County Road #77.

In 1978 and again in 1985 Landecker & Associates, Inc. find 2" pipe as set by E. B. Horst in 1916 and accepts this monument to be a perpetuation of the original Government corner.
