



STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE FOR: East quarter corner, Section 30,  
Township 135 North, Range 29 West, Cass County, Minnesota.

In 1865 the original Government Survey was performed and a wood post was set to mark this corner location.

In 1916 E. B. Horst set said corner in its lost position by single proportionate measure between the Northeast and Southeast corner said Section 30. County Book "B"

In 1947 J. W. Curo started line East from this corner.

In 1985 Landecker & Associates, Inc. finds 2" iron pipe corner set by E. B. Horst in 1916 and accepts this corner to be a perpetuation of the original Government corner.
