

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE Northeast Corner Section 3, T.135N., R.32W., 5th P.M.

- 1858 U.S. General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 8" Y. Pine N22°E 15 lks., 9" Y. Pine N53°W 27 lks., 7" Y. Pine S57°E 22 lks., 6" Y. Pine S59°W 14 lks.
- 1915 County Survey Record Book "C" page 572, shows a survey by Roy Bryant. He found the corner and 1 BT.
- 1915 County Survey Record Book "C" page 47, shows a survey by E.B. Horst. He found the corner and set a 1½ x 48" I.M. 3" N. Pine SW 41.2', 4" N. Pine NW 52.0'
- 1957 State Highway Department found a 2" I.P.  
N & D 14" Jack Pine NNE 91.8'  
N & D 14" Jack Pine NE 91.0'  
N & D 12" Jack Pine SE 80.5'
- 1985 On August 26, Terry Freeman, Cass County Survey Technician, found a 1½" I.P. down 0.2'. Also found possible 1915 BT pine stump NW tipped out by roots and 1957 Highway Dept. BT J. Pine NE 91'
- 1985 On Nov. 14, Terry Freeman and Walt Curo, Cass County Surveyor, visited corner and marked the bearings as shown on other side of this certificate.
