

- 1915 N. Gorman found hub set by John Curo from original BT's. Microfilm roll 119
- 1915 County record book B, page 108-114 show that John Curo a RLS, found evidence of original BT's and set a 2½"x48" galvanized pipe.
- 1917 County record book B, page 598 shows that E.B. Horst found the 2½"x48" pipe.
- 1942 John Curo, RLS, found the corner and marked the following BT's:

- 1985 Walter Curo, RLS, found the 2½" iron pipe, but found no trace of the BT's and mark new BT's as shown on front.
