


# CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF GOVERNMENT CORNER

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE South Quarter Corner Section 35, T.142 N., R.26 W., 5th P.M.

- 1871 U.S. General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner marked the following bearing trees: 6" Aspen S 2 E 11 lks., 12" Spruce N 52 E 34 lks.
- 1916 James Flynn found the old gov't BT's. County Book "C", page 168.
- 1919 County Book "C", page 195, new BT's: 8" W. Birch S 24-45 E 35.25', 14" Fir stump N 22 W 31.5'
- 1963 Bill Okerman, USFS Surveyor, found the remains of a 1½" iron pipe, in notes from the field book on file in the Bena Rangers Headquarters. Bill replaced the pipe with a 6"x24" concrete monument with 3" bronze tablet 0.4' below surface of old road and filed a Certificate of Location of Government Corner.
- 1986 Walter E. Curo found the 6" concrete monument and files this Certificate to update the 1963 Okerman certificate.
