

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE Southeast Corner Section 35,T.142 N.,R.26 W.,5th P.M.

- 1871 U.S. General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 12" N.Pine N 21 W 98 lks., 4" Aspen N 46 E 96 lks., 4" Aspen S 44½ E 35 lks., 6" Aspen S 68 W 118 lks.
- 1912 James Flynn found the old gov't BT's: 13" N.Pine stump N 21 W 98 lks., 9" Aspen stub N 46 E 96 lks. County Book "B", pg. 514-515.
- 1913 John Greene, Plat of FAIRVIEW CEMETARY.
- 1916 James Flynn found iron pipe in place. County Book "C", page 168.
- 1982 County Highway Dept. and Terry Freeman, Cass County Surveyors Office, found 1½" iron pipe down 2.5' and marked the following BT's: 20" N.Pine N 33 W 85.43', Punch mark N.end 15" CMP N 56 W 27.59', Punch mark S.end 15" CMP S 54 W 34.20'
- 1986 Walter E. Curo found the pipe 2.5' down & set a 2"x24" galv. iron pipe with brass cap on top, 1" below surface of blacktop.
