



Statement of Evidence: South Quarter Corner Section 30, T.143 N., R.27 W.,
5th P.M.

- 1873 U.S. General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 6" Cedar S 34 E 4 lks, 6" Birch NORTH 9 lks.
- 1928 U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey set a 1"x36" iron pipe with brass cap at proportionate distance, no bearing trees available- set 4"x4"x5' cedar post alongside iron.
- 1970 On May 19, Curt Krause, US Forest Service, found I.P. with cap 10" above ground and 4"x4"x5' cedar post lying on ground next to corner. On June 22, he scribed 3 new trees: 5" Elm N 6W 33', 8" Birch N 57 E 19.8', 8" Aspen S 73 E 22.5', and set a 60" steel sign post EAST 3.3' with USFS sign 54-4.
- 1986 On July 27, Walt Curo found brass cap monument in good condition and steel sign post East, and 1970 BT's Elm NW, Birch snag NE and Aspen SE, all with old tags. Monument is 20' west of clearcut area.
