



STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE East 1/16 Corner 12/13, T 141 N., R. 31 W.

- 1917 U.S. General Land Office Resurvey set a 1x36" I.P. with Stamped brass cap and marked the following bearing trees: 12" Red Oak N 9°W 250 lks., 10" White Oak S 17 1/2°E 240 lks.
- 1985 On April 19, USFS survey crew, Curt Krause and Gary Brauma and Cass County Survey Technician, Terry Freeman, found the stub of the 1918 SE GLO B.T. Dug a 30"x40" x 42" deep hole in area of corner. No iron was found.
- 1985 On June 26, Cass County Survey Technician, Terry Freeman and USFS survey crew, Curt Krause and Jeff Allison set a 2"x2' I.P. with marked brass cap at midpoint between the N 1/4 and NE corners of Section 13, but corner was set 2' south of a straight line between said corners to hold GLO distance to stub of 1913 B.T. Stub of 1918 B.T. is S 16°E 158.4' from set iron. Marked new bearings as shown on front of this certificate.
