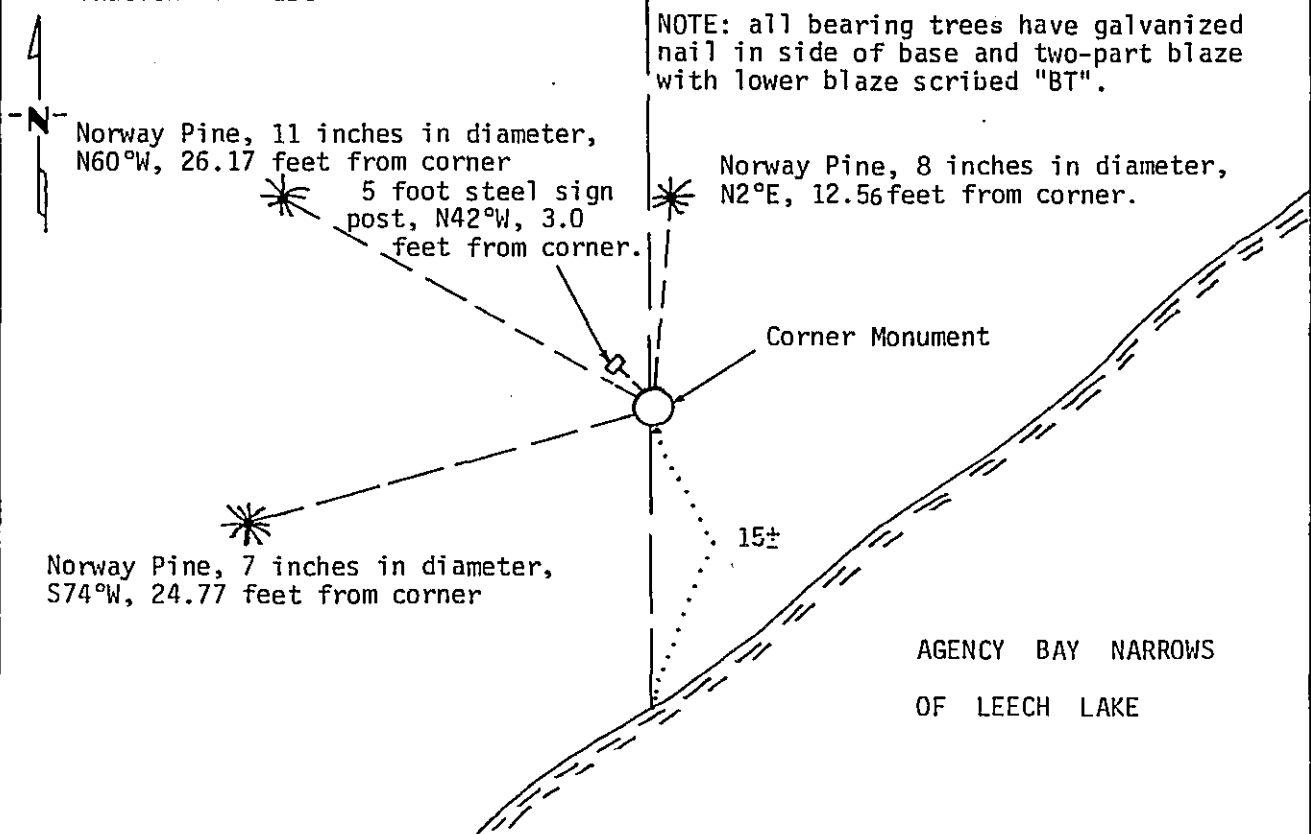

Statement of Evidence: Witness Corner to Meander Corner Between Sections 19 and 24
T. 142 N., R. 30 and 31 W., 5th P.M.

- 1873 U.S. General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 24" Yellow Pine, N.49°E. 28 links (18.48 feet), 20" Yellow Pine, N.65°W. 11 links (7.26 feet).
- 1916 E.B. Horst found both original Government bearing trees and set a post for this corner. This information is recorded in County Book "C", page 523 and on Microfilm roll number 115, Book 80, page 42.
- 1917 General Land Office set a 1" x 36" iron pipe with brass cap for a Witness Corner to the Meander Corner. Evidence of the remains of the original bearing trees were found and the position for the Meander Corner being unsafe a Witness Corner was established with new references as follows: 10" White Oak, N.8°45'E. 74 links (48.84 feet), 10" Norway Pine N.13½°W. 53 links (34.98 feet).
- 1986 On September 26, Robert W. Murray, R.L.S., found a ½ inch iron pipe fitting bearing and distance from found 1917 G.L.O. Norway Pine bearing tree. A County Monument was placed over the existing iron pipe and new references made as indicated on sketch.
