

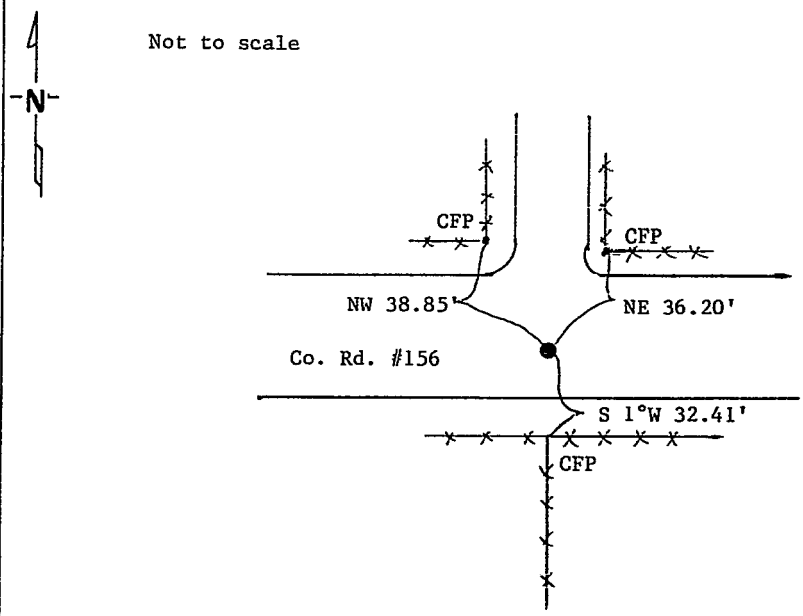
CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF GOVERNMENT CORNER

Northeast Corner of Section 14, Township 135 N., Range 32 W., 5th P.M.

At the corner location shown on the sketch:

- On 9/26/85 found a 1 1/2" x 8" I.P. down 0.3' .4' S. of centerline of road

 left monument as found, lowered monument, removed monument (explain)
- On 8/13/86 placed a cast iron monument down 0.6', placed found iron on

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE Northeast Corner Section 14, T.135 N., R.32 W., 5th P.M.

- 1866 U.S. General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 10" Maple N $1\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E 13 lks., 10" W. Oak N 56° E 58 lks., 14" W. Oak N 21° W 65 lks.
- 1916 County Survey Record Book "C", page 51, shows a survey by E.B. Horst. He found the stump hole of a W. Oak N 21° W and roots of a maple NE and set a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 48" I.M. 5" Poplar N $48\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E 90.6', 6" Poplar S $53\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E 99.6'
- 1985 On August 26, Terry Freeman, Cass County Survey Technician, found a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8" I.P. down 0.3', in line with fence S and trail N.
- 1986 On August 13, Terry Freeman and Wade Moser, pulled found I.P. and set a cast iron monument down 0.6'. Placed 8" piece of iron on W. side of monument.
