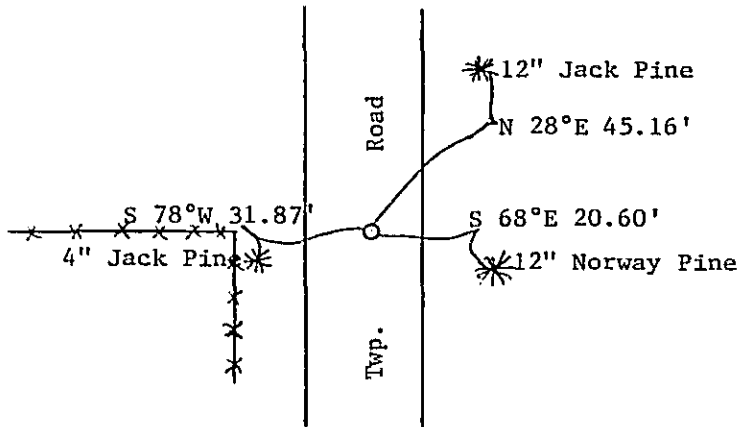
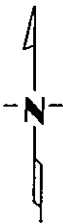

Statement of Evidence: East Quarter Corner Section 31, T.135 N., R.32W., 5th P.M.

1866 U.S. General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 8" Bl.Pine N 78°E 70 lks.
10" Bl.Pine S 34°W 50 lks.

1986 On August 25, Terry Freeman, Cass County Survey Technician and Jim Cripps found a ½" x 14" iron rod in centerline of N-S road. in line with fence W. Replaced with cast iron monument, down 10".

Although there is no record of the found iron rod, the Cass County Surveyors Office accepts it as a perpetuation of the original General Land Office corner.
