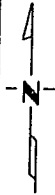

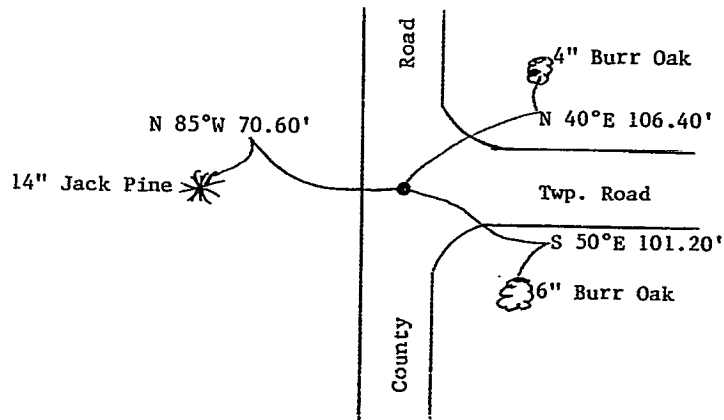

- 1858 U.S. General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 12" Sp.Pine N 36°W 14 lks., 7" Sp.Pine S 24°W 12 lks., 12" Sp.Pine S 46°E 68 lks., 8" SP.Pine N 34°E 49 lks.
- 1986 On August 25, Terry Freeman, Cass County Survey Technician and Jim Cripps found a cast iron monument labeled "County Surveyor" in intersection of roads N-S-E. Marked the ties as shown on front of this certificate.
