

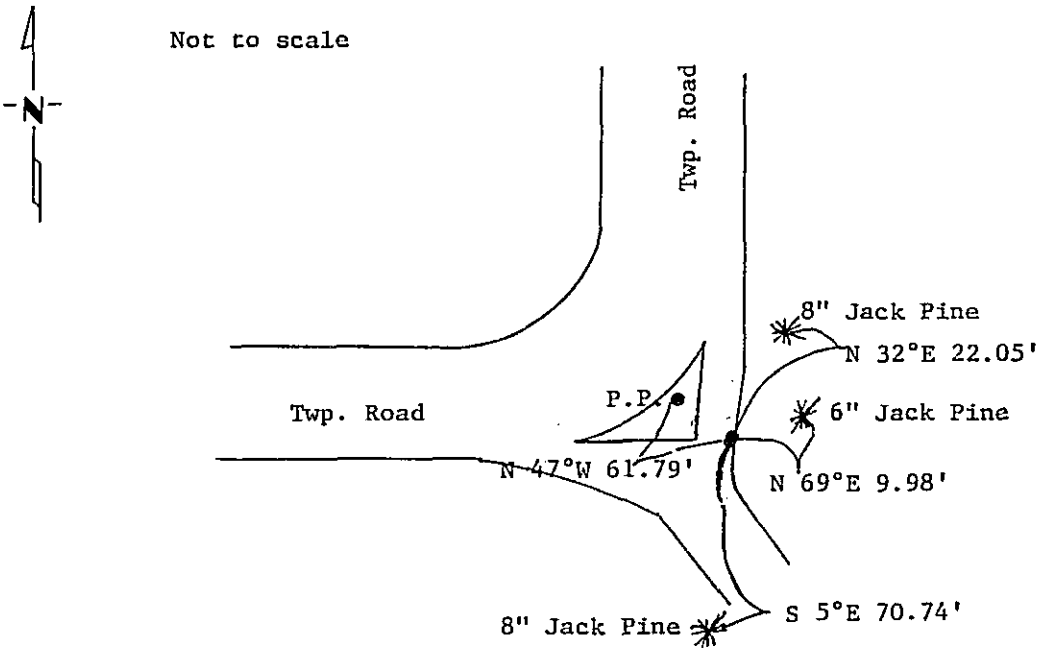
# CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF GOVERNMENT CORNER

Northeast Corner of Section 6, Township 134 N., Range 32 W., 5th P.M.  
 STATE OF MINNESOTA, County of CASS

At the corner location shown on the sketch:

- On 8/25/86 found a 1½" x 16" car spring, 12.1' N. of centerline road W.,

inline with centerline road N.  
 left monument as found,  lowered monument,  removed monument (explain)
- On 8/25/86 placed a cast iron monument down 6", with found car spring on

N. side of monument.

Statement of Evidence: Northeast Corner Section 6, T.134 N., R.32 W., 5th P.M.

1858 U.S. General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 8" Sp. Pine S 47°E 10 lks., 8" Sp. Pine S 26°W 12 lks., 10" Sp. Pine N 79°W 28 lks., 9" Sp. Pine N 44°E 45 lks.

1986 On August 25, Terry Freeman, Cass County Survey Technician and Jim Cripps found a 1½" x 16" car spring down 0.3'. Replaced with cast iron monument down 6" and placed car spring on N. side of cast iron. Marked new ties as shown on front of this certificate.

Although there is no record of the found iron, the Cass County Surveyors Office accepts it as a perpetuation of the original government corner.
