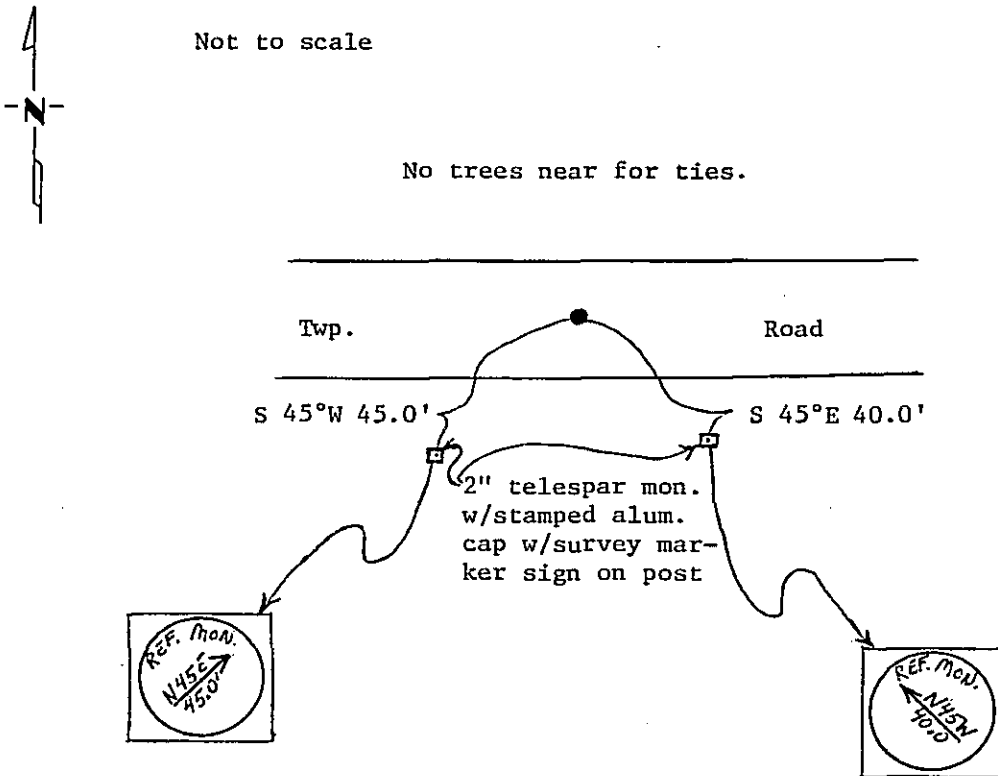

Statement of Evidence: Northeast Corner Section 4, T.134 N., R.32 W., 5th P.M.

- 1858 U.S. General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner but there were no trees available for ties.
- 1985 On Sept. 19, Terry Freeman, Cass County Survey Technician and Ken Meyer, backhoe operator dug in search area provided by Comstock & Davis. Dug 10' E-W x 8' N-S x 2.5' deep. 6" top, 2' of fill to layer of cordoroy. Found nothing.
- 1986 On August 25, Terry Freeman and Jim Cripps set a cast iron monument at proportional position E-W in centerline of road. (Proportional measurement by Comstock & Davis)
