

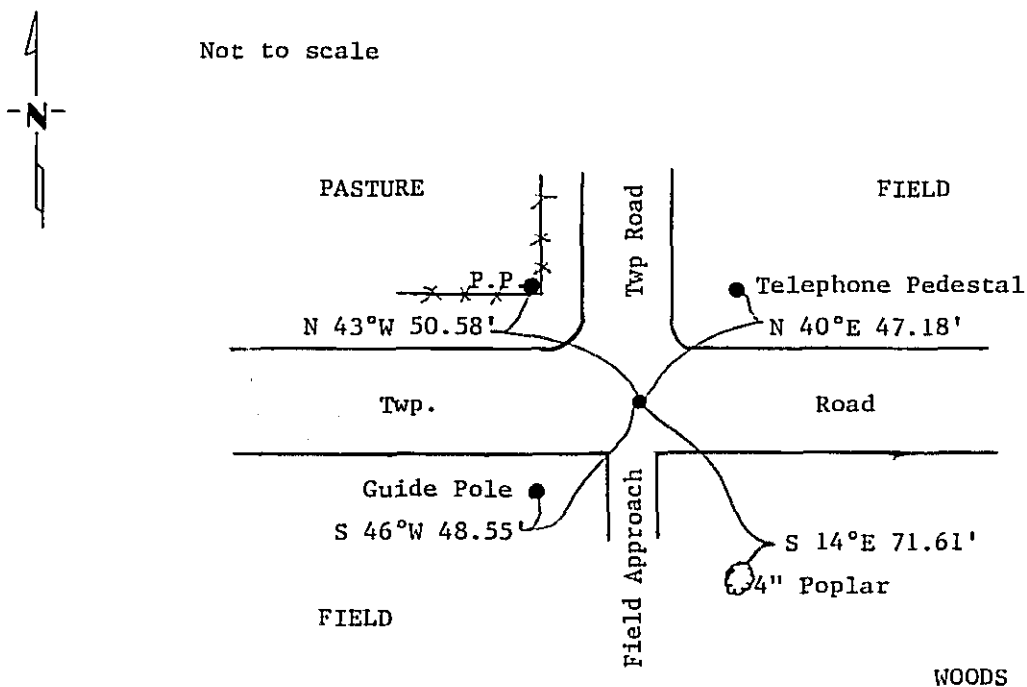

Statement of Evidence: Northeast Corner Section 2, T.134 N., R.32 W., 5th P.M.

- 1858 U.S. General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 10" Aspen N 51°E 18 lks., 12" Aspen N 74°W 66 lks., 9" Aspen S 3°E 43 lks., 9" Aspen S 18°W 26 lks.
- 1985 On August 27, Terry Freeman, Cass County Survey Technician searched in intersection of roads with metal locator, but found only loadstones.
- 1985 On Sept. 16, Terry Freeman and Ken Meyer, backhoe operator dug 8'x9' x 3.75' deep hole in intersection of roads. 3" class V, 2' fill and dug 1.5' into natural sandy-clay.
- 1986 August 14, by testimony of Joe DeGeest, local resident there was an iron monument in intersection. Terry Freeman, Jim Cripps and Norman Maunu set cast iron monument down 6" in centerline of E-W road in line with centerline of road N.
