

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

Northeast corner of Section 19, Township 136 North, Range 29 West, Cass County, Minnesota.

The original government survey was done in 1870, a post was set establishing the corner thereof.

1913 - Harry Todd found old government bearing trees, pine Northwest, tamarack stump Northeast and re-establish the corner as noted in County Survey Record Book B, page 305-309.

1986 - David Landecker, RLS #17008, Landecker & Associates, Inc. finds pine stump of original bearing tree Northwest and also finds 1½" iron set by Todd in 1913.

This corner is a perpetuation of the original corner position and is accepted as such by Landecker & Associates, Inc.
