STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

West Quarter corner, Section: 15, Township 139 North, Range 29 West, 5th P.M., Cass County, Minnesota.

- 865 U. S. General Land Office set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees:

 20" Norway pine South 3 degrees West 200 lks (132.00 feet).
- .908 J. W. Curo finds norway pine bearing tree however, measures North 300 lks instead of the government measure of 200 lks and establishes an incorrect corner for the West quarter. Book 95, Page 41 (Curo's records).
- 1920 E. B. Horst surveying Plat of Kinnie Camp uses incorrect Curo corner.
- 1983 G. Stevenson finds remains of bearing trees (stumps) while surveying said Section 15.
- 1987 Landecker & Associates, Inc. surveying crews while surveying in Section 15 found the original bearing tree stump and note old Curo iron set at fence intersection at Curo distance from stump (300 lks). Landecker & Associates, Inc. in using the original stump reset the corner government distance 200 lks Northerly and establish the perpetuation of the original government corner for the said quarter corner.
