

STATEMENT OF EVIDENCE

West quarter corner, Section 33, Township 140 North, Range 29 West,  
5th P.M., Cass County, Minnesota.

- 1870 - U. S. General Land Office set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees:  
5" black oak South 50 degrees East 11 lks, 4" black oak  
South 11 degrees West 47 lks.
- 1974 - D. Anderson surveying in Section 33 for Plat of Buckmans Bay Woods established a position for the West quarter corner for said section single proportionately between the Northwest and Southwest corners, said section, however when staking, he set the corner 25.89 feet to far to the West.
- 1987 - Landecker & Associates, Inc. find iron monument set by D. Anderson in 1974 of which it is out of position by 25.89 to the West of the computed quarter corner position. Landecker & Associates, Inc. therefore established a new monument in the correct location for the quarter corner using single proportionate method as also used by D. Anderson. D. Anderson's iron was left in place and used as a reference tie to the quarter corner monument set by Landecker.
