



Statement of Evidence:

- 1924 - U.S General Land Office dependent resurvey established this corner and an iron pipe with a marked brass cap was set to mark the corner. The following bearing trees were marked: 7" Maple N 22-00 E 32 links and 7" Maple S 77-15 W 53 links.
- 1987 - County Surveyor's Records in the Recorder's Office were checked and no resurvey information was found on this corner.
- 1987 - U.S. Forest Service office in Cass Lake was contacted for information and no resurvey information was found on this corner.
- 1987 - Found brass cap monument as described in 1924 in good condition. Found both 1924 Maple bearing trees alive with scars facing corner. Did not cut open. Distance north to quarter corner checked reasonably well with 1924 distance and in line with quarter corner and northeast corner of Section 6. Distances measured to bearing trees show that distances given in 1924 were reported interchanged.
