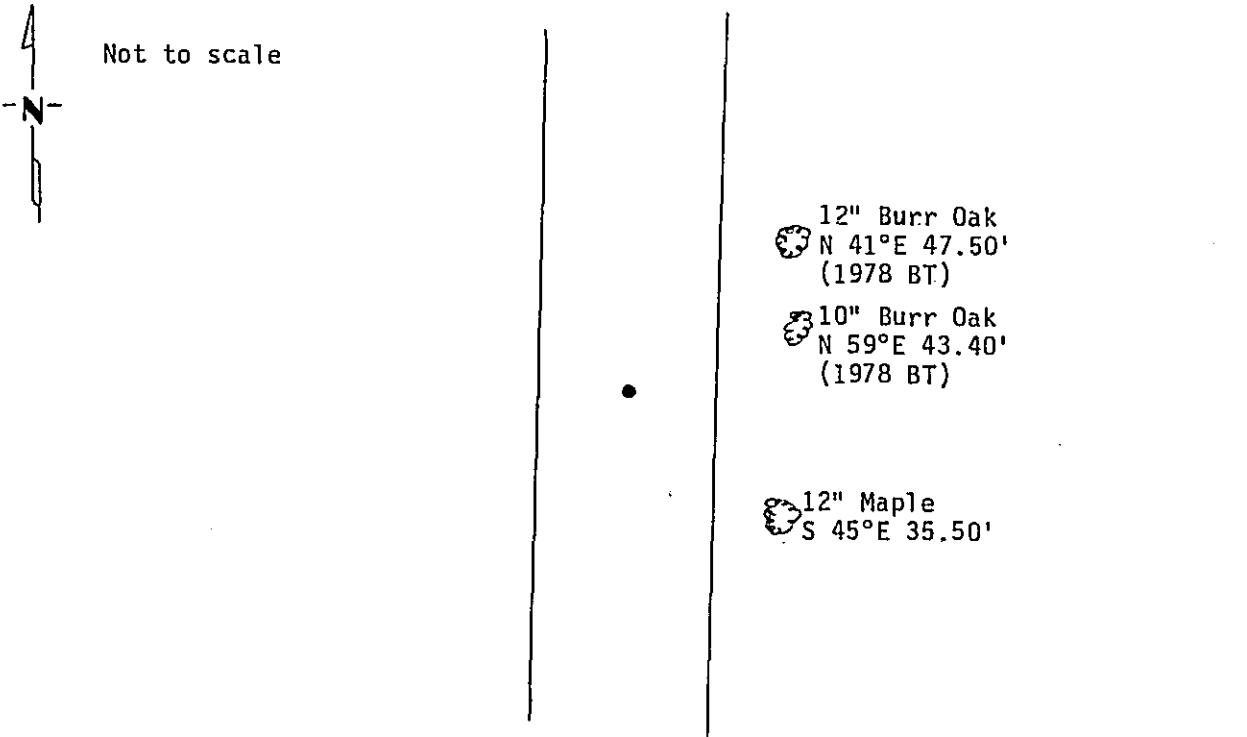

Statement of Evidence: East Quarter Corner Section 1, T.141 N.,R.28 W.,5th P.M.

- 1873 US General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing tree: 14" N.Pine S 10°W 222 lks.
- 1915 County Survey Record Book "B",page 572,shows a survey by N.D.Gorman. He found the old Gov't BT and an iron post.
- 1917 County Survey Record Book "B",page 590,shows a survey by James Flynn. He found the old BT stump. Marked new BT's: N.Pine stump S 65°W 164',9"W.Oak stump N 46-20 E 200 lks.
- 1918 US General Land Office dependent resurvey found stump of the original BT and 2" Galv. I.P. Alongside found I.P.,set 1"x36" I.P. with marked brass cap,set 36" in ground. New BT's: 8"Poplar S 5½°E 325 lks.,8"Poplar N 22 3/4°W 282 lks.
- 1919 County Survey Record Book "C",page 347,shows a survey by E.B.Horst. He found the US I.M.
- 1978 US Forest Service personnel,Stefan,Krause & Hansey, found I.M. graded out. Surveyed corner position in from S 1/16 and N-S 1/64 Corners on East line Section 1. Set 6"x6"x24" concrete monument with brass cap. The following bearings were marked: 6"W.Oak N 48°E 47.36',6"W.Oak N 65°E 43.20', 6"W.Oak S56°E 100.01',all scribed "W½ S6 BT". 6'Steel sign post EAST 24.8'
- 1979 Milo Stefan,US Forest Service Surveyor,filed Gov't Resurvey plat "E-71" and shows concrete monument as set in 1978.
- 1987 Walt Curo,under Forest Service contract,found concrete monument inplace and the 2 NE 1978 BT's. Marked a new BT SE.
