1921	County Survey Record Book "C", pages 447 and 467, show surveys by E.B. Horst. He found a 4x4x48" Oak stake, set from 3 stumps and one snag of the original BT's.
1942	County Survey Record Book "D", page 317, shows a survey by John Curo. He shows the following ties: 16"W.Oak N 8 E 36.75',7" W.Birch S 55-20 E 15.75',14" N.Pine S 46 W 46.95', 8" W.Oak N 88-34 W 47.50'
