

Statement of Evidence:

L-9

East Quarter Corner, Section 17, Township 134 North, Range 30 West, Cass County, Minnesota.

In 1868 the original government survey was done by N. Butler. A wood post was set to mark the corner. Two bearing trees witnessing said corner were marked, noted as follows:

24" Norway Pine South 27 degrees West, 65 links
23" Norway Pine South 40 degrees East, 50 links.

In 1982 Jeffrey Miller, RLS #13336 surveyor with the firm Widseth, Smith, Nolting, Brainerd, Minnesota used said corner in monumenting the section line north to Rock Lake.

In 1987 David Landecker RLS #17008 surveyor with the firm of Landecker & Associates, Inc. found 3" pipe at corner in place and also both original bearing tree stumps witnessing said corner.
