

Statement of Evidence:

T-9

East Quarter Section 29, Township 134 North, Range 30 West, Cass County, Minnesota.

In 1868 the original government survey was done by N. Butler. A wood post was set to mark the corner. Two bearing trees witnessing said corner were marked, noted as follows:

15" Pine South 64 degrees East, 9 links
16" Pine South 45 degrees West, 13 links.

In 1987 David Landecker RLS #17008 surveyor with the firm Landecker & Associates, Inc. searched for and found no evidence of said corner or bearing trees.

A monument was set at this corner as noted on the face of this Certificate in accordance with State and Federal survey standards.
