Statement of Evidence:

- 1864 U.S. General Land Office survey set wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 6" Willow S 17 E 22 links and 8" Cedar S 53 W 40 links.
- 1987 County Surveyor's Records in the Recorder's Office were checked and no resurvey information was found on this corner.
- Survey notes of Robert F. Schneider, RLS No. 5740, show 1½" iron pipe found on shore of Woman Lake. Schneider's records contained a survey by Harold Curo, RLS No. 3417, dated March 8, 1961 which showed an iron monument at this location. Mr. Schneider accepted iron as marking the meander corner position and based metes and bounds surveys in Gov't Lot 10, Sec. 6, 140-28 on the found iron. In 1971, Mr. Schneider conducted additional surveys in Sec. 6 involving the subdivision of Sec. 6.

Curo's survey also shows iron at N 1/16th corner of Sec. I and Sec. 6. Mr. Schneider extended these irons north to intersect the 10th Standard Parallel and found this computed position to fit very well with the GLO distances. SW corner of Sec. 31, 141-28 east to intersection was found to be 757.75' compared to GLO distance of 759.0'. Intersection to iron found at MC#27 was found to be 858.61' compared to GLO distance of 858.0'.

14" iron pipe was found as called for in Schneider's notes and position verified by tieing to Schneider's traverse points. No evidence was found of the GLO bearing trees. I accepted the iron pipe as the best available evidence of the meander corner position. A cass County monument was set over the found pipe and ties taken as shown on this Certificate.
