

## Statement of Evidence:

- 1928 U.S. General Land Office survey set wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 14" Elm S  $76^{\circ}15'$  E 263 links. Notes show corner in marsh.
- 1949 AUDITORS PLAT NO. 10 surveyed by Harold Curo, RLS No. 3417. Survey plat shows U.S. iron monument in place.
- 1987 Found USGLO brass cap monument in open marsh in good condition. Also found 1928 GLO bearing tree now 24" Elm snag with old scar S  $76^{\circ}23'$  E 173.9' to center. Center of Elm was rotted out and no evidence remained of scribing. Distances and bearings to other GLO corners set in 1928 checked good. New ties were taken as shown on this certificate.
