

Statement of Evidence:

Witness corner to Meander corner Sections 3 and 10 West shore of Mabel Lake (Meander Corner No. 9)

1-11-1874 P.H. Conger, Deputy Surveyor set post and witnessed as follows:

Birch 5" South 10 degrees East 14 links (9.24 feet)

Said records are filed with the Secretary of State, St. Paul, MN.

1972 W. Spain, Registered Land Surveyor indicates a monument in place on the PLAT OF LA CASA J & R between the Quarter corner to Sections 3 and 10 and the West margin of Mabel Lake. Said plat is of record in the office of the Cass County Register of Deeds.

10-21-1987 Personnel of Kovanen Surveying found "I" beam monument at position indicated on 1972 Spain plat.

1-21-1988 Personnel of Kovanen Surveying set a 2" by 4' brass capped monument as a witness, 6.70 feet West of the lost position of Meander Corner No. 9 (which falls in Mabel Lake) as established by single proportion between existing adjacent corners. The witnesses to this position are shown on the sketch.

This is not a perpetuation of the original GLO corner.
