Statement of Evidence:

- U.S. General Land Office survey set wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 6" Birch N 48 W 23 links, 4" Balsam N 60 E 24 links, 8" W. Birch S 46 W 38 links, and 4" Balsam S 54 E 27 links.
- U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey found the corner marked by a local pine stake 2"x2"x40" from which remains of Birch stumps of the SW and NW original bearing trees were found. A concrete monument with a marked brass cap was set to mark the corner.
