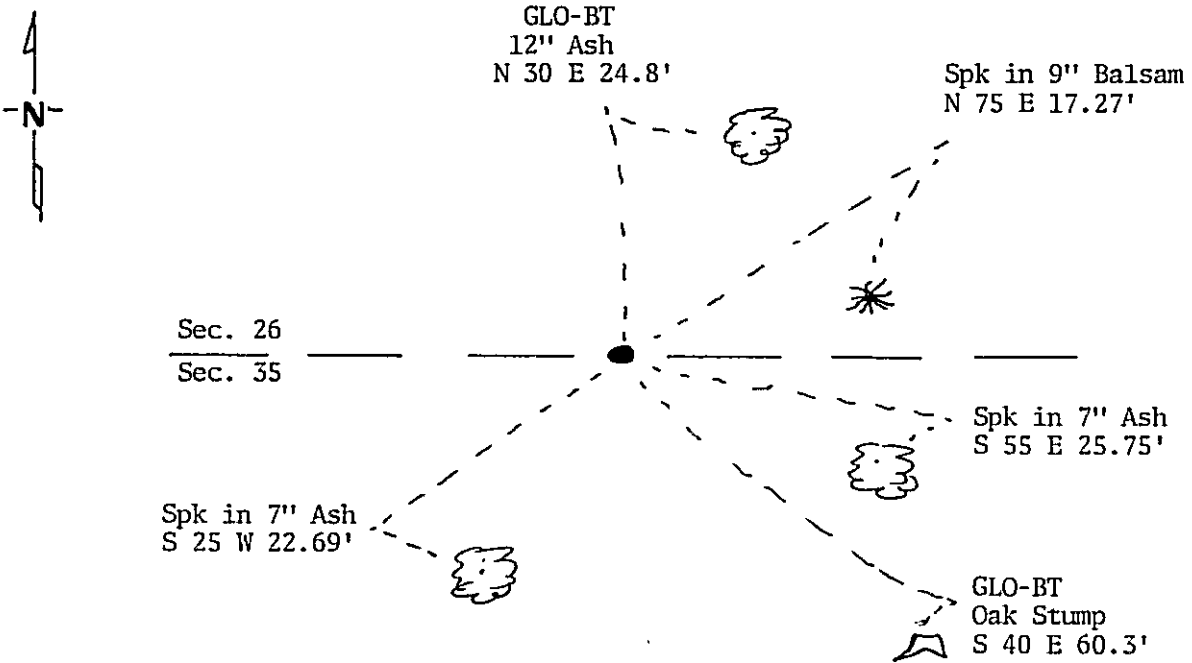

Statement of Evidence:

- 1930 U.S. General Land Office dependent resurvey established this corner and an iron pipe with a marked brass cap was set to mark the corner. The following bearing trees were marked: 4" Ash N 37½ E 37 links and 12" W. Oak S 44 E 91 links.
- 1987 County Surveyor's Records in the Recorder's Office were checked and no resurvey information was found on this corner.
- 1987 U.S. Forest Service office in Cass Lake was contacted for information and no resurvey information was found on this corner.
- 1987 Found GLO brass cap in good condition. 12" Ash was found fitting the call for the bearing tree to the NE and remains of an oak stump was found fitting the call for the bearing tree to the SE. Measured west to northwest corner of Sec. 35 and east to MC No. 5. Distances checked very well with the 1930 survey and monument was within a foot of being on line. Accepted monument as the government corner and took ties as shown on this certificate.
