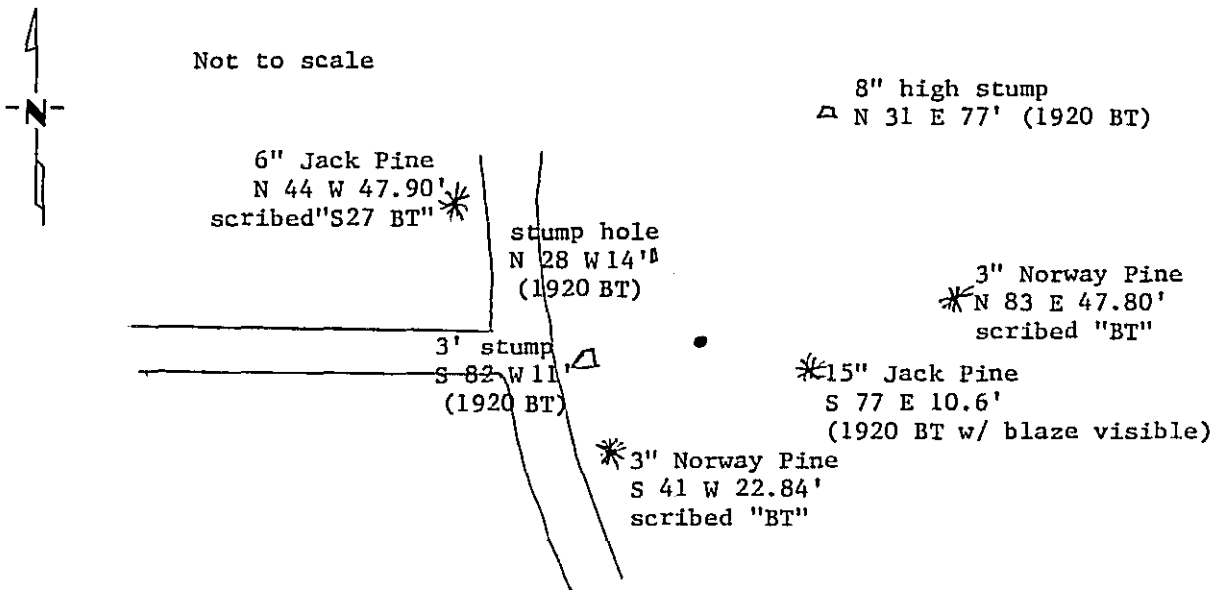

Statement of Evidence: Northeast Corner Section 34, T.140 N., R.31. W., 5th P.M.

- 1870 US General Land Office survey set a wood post for this corner and marked the following bearing trees: 8" Sp.Pine S $76\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E 18 lks., 12" Sp.Pine N 46° E 25 lks., 14" Sp.Pine N $77\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W 19 lks.
- 1920 County Surveyor E.B.Horst's notes, in Curo's notes Book 166 page 23, show that he found stumps of NW & SE Gov't BT's. He set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ "x30" I.M. with cap and marked 4 new BT's: 6" J.Pine N 31-00 E 77.2', 6" J.Pine N 28-30 W 14', 5" J.Pine S 82-30 W 11', 6" J.Pine S 77-00 E 10.6'
- 1983 County Survey Technician Terry Freeman and County Forester Larry Olson, found 2" I.P with cap and SW & SE 1920 BT's still living. Temporary ties: 12" J.pine S 27° E 21.91' with CCLD tag, 12" Aspen N 47° E 21.07'
- 1987 On October 6, Terry Freeman and Dan Marcum, County Forester, found I.P. still in good condition, however, SW 1920 BT and SE 1983 temporary tie both cut off. Also found the stump of 1920 BT NE and stump hole & piece of pine wood with axe marks at bearing & distance to 1920 BT. Mark 3 new BT's: 3" N.Pine N 83° E 47.80' scribed "BT", 3" N.Pine S 41° W 22.84' scribed "BT", 6" J.Pine N 44° W 47.90' scribed "S27 BT", 7' steel sign post with Land Survey Monument sign WEST 1'
